

## How to install, uninstall, activate, and deactivate HEAT2 silently (April 23, 2017)

It is now possible to silently install, uninstall, activate, and deactivate HEAT2 using a command line in a batch-file. The feature for activation/deactivation was added in the HEAT2 v10.12 update dated April 23, 2017. (Make sure that you have at least this date in the About-box since the first version v10.12 April 14 did not have the option for silent activation/deactivation).

### Installation

Make a command file (e.g. "HEAT2\_install.cmd") with this text and run to install:

```
HEAT2_v10_setup /VERYSILENT /SUPPRESSMSGBOXES
```

After installation, activation is necessary, see below.

See Appendix A for more options.

### Uninstallation

Upon installation, the uninstall file "unins000.exe" will be created in folder

```
"C:\Program Files (x86)\BLOCON\HEAT2_vX.XX"
```

Make a command file (e.g. "HEAT2\_Uninstall.cmd") with this text:

```
unins000 /VERYSILENT /SUPPRESSMSGBOXES
```

Copy to folder above and run to uninstall HEAT2. Note that HEAT2 also will be automatically deactivated upon uninstallation, so deactivation before uninstallation (when using "unins000.exe") is not necessary.

### Activation

Place a command file (e.g. "HEAT2\_activate.cmd") in folder "C:\Program Files (x86)\BLOCON\HEAT2\_v10.12" (or where HEAT2\_v10\_12.exe is located) with this text:

```
HEAT2_v10_12 activate yourproductkey
```

A file "ActivationLog.txt" will be created (or appended if it already exists) in folder "C:\Users\username\Documents\Blocon\HEAT2 10"

A correct activation will be shown in this file as

```
HEAT2 v10.12 2017-04-21 at 11:53:47. ACTIVATE. Result: Activated
```

Tips: delete the command file afterwards in order not to expose your product key.

### Deactivation

Place a command file (e.g. "HEAT2\_deactivate.cmd") in folder "C:\Program Files (x86)\BLOCON\HEAT2\_v10.12" (or where HEAT2\_v10\_12.exe is located) with this text:

```
HEAT2_v10_12 deactivate yourproductkey
```

A file "ActivationLog.txt" will be created (or appended if it already exists) in folder "C:\Users\username\Documents\Blocon\HEAT2 10"

A correct deactivation will be shown in this file as

```
HEAT2 v10.12 2017-04-21 at 11:58:18. DEACTIVATE. Result: Deactivated
```

Tips: delete the command file afterwards in order not to expose your product key.

## Disabling check for updates

HEAT2 will by default check if there is any available update about once in ten starts (10% of the time).

To disable the check, place a file named 'nocheck.txt' in the same folder as the exe-file, e.g. in folder C:\Program Files (x86)\BLOCON\HEAT2\_v10.12

Also, if the user manually tries to check for updates, this message will come:  
"No permission for that."

## Appendix A

The Inno Setup install parameters that are required for silent installation:

/SILENT	Runs the installer in silent mode (The progress window is displayed)
/VERYSILENT	Very silent mode. No windows are displayed.
/SUPPRESSMSGBOXES	Suppress message boxes. Only has an effect when combined with '/SILENT' and '/VERYSILENT'.
/NOCANCEL	Disables cancelling the installation process.
/NORESTART	Prevents installer from restarting the system even if it's necessary.
/DIR="x:\dirname"	Overrides the default install directory.

## Example

Silently install the program, prevent restarting the system.

```
setup.exe /VERYSILENT /SUPPRESSMSGBOXES /NORESTART
```
